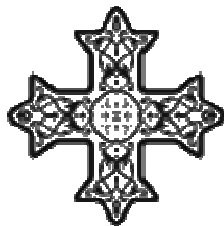

- Continue on Highway 162 for another 1.8 miles.
- Turn left onto Chapel Road and go 1.2 miles.
- St. Paul's is on the left.
- The Ministry Center is on the right.

From the South:

- Take 17 North.
- Turn RIGHT onto SC-174 (towards Edisto) and continue for 2.6 miles.
- Stay STRAIGHT to go onto SC-162 (to Hollywood) and continue for 4.6 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto CHAPEL RD.
- Our cemetery and Old St. Paul's are on the left.
- The Ministry Center and new Church are on the right.
